ITINERARY

- DAY 1** Friday, March 4
OVERNIGHT FLIGHT TO ROME
- DAY 2** Saturday, March 5
BENVENUTI TO ITALY
Board the coach and head south to Minori on the Amalfi coast. Pizza welcome dinner.
- DAY 3** Sunday, March 6
AMALFI & MAIORI CONCERTS
Celebrate High Mass with the Bellarmine Choir in Amalfi followed by free time. Then continue to Maiori for a special reception, dinner and concert. Maiori and its citizens have been frequently featured in feature films by Rossellini.
- DAY 4** Monday, March 7
DOLCE VITA DAY
Enjoy the Amalfi Coast at your own pace with optional trips to Pompeii and Capri (cost not included). Concert opportunity for the Jazz Combo.
- DAY 5** Tuesday, March 8
VIA MONTECASSINO TO TUSCANY
Bid farewell to the Amalfi Coast as you travel North. Stop for a guided tour & Mass at the Benedictine Monastery of Montecassino perched high upon a hill. Continue to Arezzo or Montecatini, your base for the next three nights, for dinner and overnight.
- DAY 6** Wednesday, March 9
FLORENCE VISIT & CONCERT
See the highlights of Tuscany's capital city (entrance to Accademia Museum included) followed by an afternoon at leisure. Evening gig for the Jazz Combo.

- DAY 7** Thursday, March 10
MONTEPULCIANO CONCERT
Visit Siena, then Montepulciano and prepare for a highlight concert and reception by local officials to celebrate the special relationship with Bellarmine University.
- DAY 8** Friday, March 11
VIA ASSISI TO ROME
Travel to Rome with a stop in Assisi for a guided tour and High Mass participation for the choir at the Basilica of St. Francis.
- DAY 9** Saturday, March 12
ETERNAL ROME TOUR
Guided tour of Rome's ancient highlights, mainly the Colosseum and Roman Forum. Exchange opportunity with local musicians and likely concert in the evening. While in Rome, visit the Church of the Gesu (Robert Bellarmine preached there) and St. Ignatius (where Robert Bellarmine is buried).
- DAY 10** Sunday, March 13
VATICAN VISIT & HIGH MASS
Explore the Vatican Museums and St. Peter's Basilica with your local guide followed by some free time. The singers will be the featured guest choir for a special Sunday High Mass in the early evening at the magnificent cathedral of St. Peter. Thereafter, head out to the Castelli Romani region for an exclusive wine-tasting and fantastic farewell dinner with local specialties and music.
- DAY 11** Monday, March 14
ROME DEPARTURE
Transfer to the airport for your flight home to the US. After check-in, your tourmanager waves good-bye and you will bid farewell to beautiful Italy.
