

### Creating a New Account

1. Go to [www.collegecentral.com/bellarmino](http://www.collegecentral.com/bellarmino) and click on the "Alumni" icon.
2. If you are creating a new account, click the "Register Now" link. Create an Access ID (up to 12 letters, numbers and/or the underscore character) and a Password (up to 10 letters, numbers and/or the underscore character).
3. Enter required Name and Contact Information, specify your Preferences and Qualifications and select your desired Email Authorization before clicking the "Submit Information" button.
4. When registration is complete, click on the "My Home Page" link at the bottom of the screen.

### Accessing an Existing Account

1. Go to [www.collegecentral.com/bellarmino](http://www.collegecentral.com/bellarmino) and click on the "Alumni" icon.
2. Click the "Log in at Alumni Central" link.
3. Enter "**Bellarmino University**" in the "Your School" field. Enter the Access ID and Password you created at registration. Pressing "Enter" or click "Go" to get to your personal home page.

### Accessing the Mentoring Network

1. Log in to your CollegeCentral account using the instructions above.
2. To find a Bellarmine mentor, click the "Search for Mentors" link. Choose your criteria and click the "Begin Search" button.
3. To serve Bellarmine students, alumni and community members as a mentor, click the "Become a Mentor" link toward the bottom of the page. Enter "**knightnet**" as the Mentoring Password and click the "Access Mentoring Network" button. Click the "Add My Profile" link to enter required information, contact preferences, profile questions and mentoring preferences. Click the "Save Profile" button and then on the "Mentoring Network Home" link. Click "Update My Profile" to edit your information.
