

Creating a New Account

1. Go to www.collegecentral.com/bellarmine and click on the “Employers” icon.
2. If you are creating a new account, click on the “Register Now” link. Enter all required contact information and your organization’s description, web address and industry. If appropriate, enter your initials to indicate EOE compliance.
3. Create an Access ID consisting of up to 12 letters, numbers and/or the underscore character. Click the “Register” button.
4. Once your new account has been approved by the Career Development staff, usually the same business day, your Password will be sent to you by email. Please call our office if you need immediate assistance with your account or job listings.

Logging Into an Existing Account

1. Go to www.collegecentral.com/bellarmine and click on the “Employers” icon.
2. Click the “Online Services” link toward the bottom of the page.
3. Enter your Access ID and Password and click on the “Access Account” button. If necessary, you can also retrieve your Access ID and/or Password from this page. Please contact our office if you need any help with your account or job listings.
