## COURSE A: Nursing

**Title:** NURS 410/415 Community & Public Health Nursing

**Course Description:** This course provides an overview of community & public health nursing theory and practice, emphasizing health promotion and disease prevention across the lifespan. Students will have clinical experiences in a cross-cultural health care system.

**Prerequisites:** Junior level nursing courses at Bellarmine University; Spanish language ability a plus

**Credit Hrs:** 5 (billed by Bellarmine as summer tuition)

## COURSE B: IDC 301

**Title:** IDC. 301- Trans-cultural Experience: Culture and Health Care in Ecuador

**Course Description:** This course will explore health care beliefs/practices and delivery systems for persons in Ecuador, South America. At the end of the course, students will be able to identify culturally appropriate health interventions in caring for people from Ecuador.
