REGISTRATION INFORMATION UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

Currently Enrolled Returning Undergraduates First Time Degree Seeking Undergraduate Students

Web registration is required for all undergraduate students who are currently enrolled and are seeking their first undergraduate degree. See the section in this document entitled Web Registration Procedures and Policies for more information on how to register.

All Other Current Undergraduates

Web registration is not available to undergraduate students in the following categories. Registration procedures are outlined for each category below.

- Post Baccalaureate Accelerated Nursing Students students
 will be registered by the Nursing Department Chair working directly
 with the Registrar's Office and will be notified when their registration has been completed.
- Post Baccalaureate Accounting Certificate Students students must contact their program advisor, Dr. Richard Schrader, to register. Fill out a Registration Worksheet found on the Registrar's Office website and submit it to Dr. Schrader for approval and registration.
- Post Baccalaureate Degree Seeking Students in all Other Undergraduate Programs - students in these programs must obtain approval of their course selections using the Registration Worksheet found on the Registrar's Office website and must bring it to the Registrar's Office in person register. The form must be signed by the student's advisor.
- **Returning Exchange Students** register with the International Programs Office (IPO); contact that office directly for more information.
- Non-Degree Students returning non-degree students may register for classes directly with the Registrar's Office beginning November 11. Use the Registration Worksheet found on the Registrar's Office website. An advisor's signature is not required for non-degree students.

New Undergraduate Students

Undergraduate students who will be new to Bellarmine or who will be readmitted for Spring 2011 may register on or after November 17 and after admission or readmission to the University. Course registration will be part of your admission or readmission process. Contact your admission counselor for details.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION GRADUATE STUDENTS

Currently Enrolled Returning Graduate Students

Web registration is required for students in the following graduate programs. See the section in this document entitled Web Registration Procedures and Policies for more information on how to register.

- Master of Arts in Communication contact Dr. Ruth Wagoner for advising and web registration clearance.
- Master of Science in Applied Information Technology contact Professor Dick Jones for advising and web registration clearance.
- Master of Business Administration web registration clearance will automatically be granted for you prior to the opening of registration. For any questions regarding advising and web registration clearance, contact Ms. Janet Russell in the MBA Office.
- Graduate Nursing Students (MSN and DNP) contact your program advisor for advising and web registration clearance.

Students in the following graduate programs are not eligible for web registration. Registration procedures are outlined for each category below.

- Doctor of Physical Therapy students will be registered by Dr. Mark Wiegand working directly with the Registrar's Office and will be notified when their registration has been completed.
- Master of Arts in Spirituality contact Dr. Greg Hillis for advising and registration. Use the Registration Worksheet available on the Registrar's Office website for your Bellarmine courses. Use Metroversity forms to register for any LPTS courses. Submit all forms to Dr. Hillis for approval and registration.
- Graduate Education (all programs) contact your program advisor for advising and registration procedures.

Currently Enrolled Non-Degree Graduate Students

Web registration is not available for non-degree graduate students. You may register for classes directly with the Registrar's Office beginning November 11 using the Registration Worksheet found on the Registrar's Office website. An advisor's signature is not required for non-degree students.

New Graduate Students

Graduate students who will be new to Bellarmine for Spring 2011 may register on or after November 17 and after admission to the University. Course registration will be part of your admission process. Contact your admission counselor for details.

Readmitted or Returning Graduate Students Not Currently Enrolled

Graduate students who are not new to Bellarmine but who are not currently registered for Fall 2010 are not eligible for web registration. Contact your program advisor for readmission or re-entry and registration procedures.

GENERAL REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Special Registration Approvals

- Forms Required Some classes require special forms to register and cannot be completed on the web (e.g. Internships, Independent Studies, Contract Courses, Music Lessons and Ensembles, Metroversity courses). Forms for these are available at the Registrar's Office.
- Overload Approval Students wishing to pursue a credit overload must obtain approval using the Credit Overload Form, available on the Registrar's Office website. A per credit tuition overload charge will apply; contact the Bursar's Office for amount.

Authorization Approval

- **Undergraduate Students** An Authorization Form is available on the Registrar's Office website and can be used to seek approval to register for a class 1) that is closed 2) for which you are missing the prerequisite, 3) that has a registration restriction, or 4) has a slight overlap in time with another course. All procedural information is included on that form.
- **Graduate Students** Graduate students seeking special registration approval may be authorized into a course only with permission of the graduate program director. He or she will contact the Registrar's Office directly on your behalf to request the authorization entry.

- Bellarmine students visiting other Metroversity schools must complete a Metroversity registration form at Bellarmine and submit it to the host institution's Registrar's Office according to the registration schedule of that

school but no later than Bellarmine's last day to add and drop courses.

Students from other Metroversity schools visiting Bellarmine must complete a Metroversity form at their home school and submit it to Bellarmine's Registrar's Office no sooner than December 10, 2010.

WEB REGISTRATION PROCEDURES & POLICIES

Web Registration Procedures

1. Prepare your course selections:

- a. Review the requirements for your degree in the Bellarmine University Catalog or other official documents given to you by your advisor.
- b. Review a copy of your unofficial transcript to refresh your memory about the classes you have already completed. Also, verify that credits from any other institutions have been recorded properly. You may only obtain a copy of your unofficial transcript in person at the Registrar's Office (bring your photo ID).
- Obtain a blank Registration Worksheet from the Registrar's Office website.
- d. Complete the worksheet by listing your first choice classes as well as any alternates. See FAQs on the Registrar's Office website for more information about alternates.

2. Determine your registration "Time Ticket"

Login to myBellarmine to view your registration "time ticket" assignment; this is the precise date and time that you may begin to register. Mark your calendar with this information so that you can plan to register as close to the opening of your time ticket as reasonably possible. Spring 2011 time ticket assignments will be available to view on myBellarmine on October 15, 2010.

3. Check your Hold status

If you suspect you might have a financial hold check with the Bursar's Office prior to registration, allowing plenty of time to take care of any holds that will prevent registration.

4. Obtain approval from your Advisor

Arrange an advising appointment with your advisor. Present your completed Registration Worksheet to your advisor for his/her approval. Upon completion of your appointment, your advisor must complete two actions: 1) he/ she must login to their own myBellarmine account and grant you registration clearance for the proper semester and 2) he/she must sign your registration worksheet. Web registration will not work without electronic clearance granted by your advisor. The signature on the registration worksheet will serve as proof of your advisor's approval in the event that you need help from the Registrar's Office.

Note for graduate MBA students: you will not complete the advising and registration worksheet process and will automatically be pre-cleared for registration.

Note for graduate students in Nursing, MAIT, and Communications: your advisor may present you with an alternate advising appointment plan, possibly via email or phone; contact that person for details.

5. Register for classes

a. When your time ticket opens, login to myBellarmine, click on the [Student] tab, then the (Registration) link. You will see a box entitled Holds. If you have any holds that will prevent you from registering, they will be marked as an Absolute Registration Hold. If your hold status is clear or listed as Informational only, you may proceed.

- b. Next, click the Add/Drop Courses link to begin the registration process. Remember to enter the correct Term and Program for registration. Have your registration worksheet with you when you register; it will help remind you what your advisor has approved and will also facilitate the entry of your course selections into the registration screen.
- c. See Web Registration Tips on the Registrar's Office website for more information about navigating inside the registration system.

6. Print a copy of your Class Schedule

If you wish, print a copy of your schedule for your records. Your advisor will automatically receive a copy of your schedule via email. If your registration is complete and you do not need further assistance, keep your signed worksheet for your reference; you do not need to turn it in.

7. Need additional help?

Web Registration Policies

1. Web Registration Eligibility

All eligible students must register on the web. Advisors do not have the ability to enter registrations. To be eligible for web registration, students must be:

- a. Currently registered for Fall 2010;
- b. Seeking their first Bellarmine undergraduate degree, or a graduate degree in Nursing, Communication, MAIT or MBA;
- c. Either full-time or part-time;
- d. Planning to graduate in a semester other than Spring 2011.

2. Time Ticket Policies

- a. Students register by classification with graduate and post baccalaureate students first, seniors before juniors, juniors before sophomores, etc., as outlined on the academic calendar. Seniors are defined as 90 or more completed credits, juniors have completed 60-89 credits, sophomores have completed 30-59 credits, and freshmen have less than 30 completed credits.
- b. Within each classification, students are assigned a specific time ticket. The time ticket is the precise date and time that registration opens for each individual student.
- c. Time ticket assignment is done in order to control the volume of traffic on the myBellarmine server. Time tickets assign students to reasonably sized groups that can be handled by the server.
- d. Time tickets are assigned by a randomly generated computer program.
- e. Students whose time tickets open while in class are strongly advised to wait until after class to register. Instructors are not obligated to honor registration as a valid excused absence.
- f. Students who think their time ticket should be assigned to a higher classification should check the number of cumulative earned credits on their Bellarmine transcript. For further questions, contact the Registrar's Office.

3. Advisor Approval Policies

- a. Students must have advisor approval to register. The electronic version of advisor approval is when he or she grants "registration clearance". Students must obtain electronic clearance only from their official advisor. Students must contact their advisor directly if clearance has not been granted.
- b. Advisor information can be viewed by students on myBellarmine. Only the student's official assigned advisor can grant registration clearance. For questions about advisors, contact the Academic Resource Center (ARC) at 502.272.8071.
- c. Students are strongly encouraged to obtain their advisor's signature on their registration worksheet. In the event that registration assistance is needed, the Registrar's Office will require proof of the advisor's approval; this signature will provide that proof.
- d. Students with more than one official advisor may go to either advisor for electronic clearance and a signature on the worksheet. Exception: Secondary Education teacher licensure candidates must work with both a major advisor and an Education advisor prior to registration.
- e. If extenuating circumstances prevent a student from obtaining advisor approval (electronic clearance or signed worksheet), he/she may request a signature on the registration worksheet from the department chair of their major, the academic dean of their school, or a professional advisor in the ARC. Approval from any of these parties is at their discretion. Once a signature is obtained on the worksheet, the student may bring it to the Registrar's Office for assistance. The Registrar's Office will only register students with a valid signature.

4. Registration Changes

- a. Once a student's time ticket is open, it will remain open through the day before spring term begins (January 5, 2011). This will allow students to make any necessary changes to their own schedule.
- b. Changes made by students will automatically be emailed to their advisor. Advisors do not need to approve changes but students are strongly encouraged to discuss any changes with them in advance. Students must accept responsibility for any registration changes made without advisor consultation.
- c. Once the semester begins, students have one week to add/drop classes. During this week all add/drops must be done in person at the Registrar's Office.

TUITION & FEE INFORMATION

Full-Time Undergraduate Students – More than eleven (11) and no greater than nineteen (19) credits = \$14,580 per semester. More than nineteen (19) credits (petition required) = \$690 per credit hour for credits in excess of 19.

Part-Time Undergraduate Students – Eleven (11) credits or less = \$690 per credit hour. Audit Students = 1/3 tuition.

Graduate Students – Varies by program.

Tuition Payment Plan

Information on payment plan options may be obtained from the Bursar's Office, Room HORR210.

Tuition and Fees Deadline

Tuition and fees may be paid any time after registration but should be paid by February 4, 2011. Students who do not pay their tuition and fees or select a payment plan by this deadline will be subject to interest charges.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

A student who finds it necessary to drop a course or withdraw from the University after registration must provide written notification to the Office of the Registrar.

The effective date of withdrawal is the date on which the withdrawal notification is received in the Registrar's Office. This date is used in calculating any applicable tuition reduction/refund.

All full-time undergraduate students are required to meet with a representative of the Academic Resource Center (ARC) prior to withdrawing from the University.

Students who fail to comply with this policy will receive an F for all courses for which they are registered and be responsible for corresponding tuition and fees.

When a student officially withdraws from the University or from any course, or courses, charges will be adjusted according to the refund schedule listed below. The full amount of tuition will be due unless the withdrawal occurs during the refund period; all fees are non-refundable. Also, refer to the "Adjustments & Refunds of Tuition" section listed in the University Catalog.

INSTITUTIONAL FINANCIAL AID REFUND POLICY

When a student has Institutional financial aid from Bellarmine University and completely withdraws during the time that a tuition refund is due, the student is eligible to keep the same percentage of Institutional financial aid that they are charged for tuition. The remaining aid is refunded to the financial aid programs.

Treatment of Federal Title IV Aid After Withdrawal

The law specifies how Bellarmine University must determine the amount of Federal Title IV program assistance that you earn if you withdraw from school. The Title IV programs that are covered by this law are Federal Pell Grants, Federal Direct Stafford Loans, Direct PLUS Loans, Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants (FSEOGs), Federal Per-

kins Loans, Academic Competitive Grants (ACG), SMART Grants, and TEACH Grants. When you withdraw during the semester the amount of Title IV program assistance that you have earned up to that point is determined by a specific formula. If you received (or Bellarmine or your parent received on your behalf) less assistance than the amount that you earned, you may be able to receive those additional funds. If you receive more assistance than you earned, the excess funds must be returned by Bellarmine and/or you.

The amount of assistance that you have earned is determined on a prorata basis. For example, if you completed 30 percent of your semester, you earn 30 percent of the assistance you were originally scheduled to receive. Once you have completed more than 60 percent of the semester, you earn all of the assistance that you were scheduled to receive for that semester. If you did not receive funds that you earned, you may be due a post-withdrawal disbursement. If the post-withdrawal disbursement includes loan funds, Bellarmine must get your permission before it can disburse them. You may choose to decline some or all of your loan funds, you have fourteen days to choose to decline the additional loan funds so that you don't incur additional debt. Bellarmine will automatically use all or a portion of your post-withdrawal disbursement (including loan funds if you accept them) for tuition, fees, and room and board charges. Bellarmine needs your permission to use the post-withdrawal disbursement for all other school charges. If you do not give your permission, you will be offered the funds. However, it may be in your best interest to allow Bellarmine to keep the funds to reduce your debt.

There are some Title IV funds that you were scheduled to receive that cannot be dispersed to you once you withdraw because of other eligibility requirements. For example, if you are a first time, first year undergraduate student and you have not completed the first 30 days of your program before you withdraw, you will not earn any Federal Stafford or Federal Plus loan funds that you would have received had you remained enrolled past the 30th day.

If you receive (or Bellarmine or your parent receives on your behalf) excess Title IV program funds that must be returned, Bellarmine must return a portion of the excess equal to the lesser of: 1. Your institutional charges multiplied by the unearned percentage of your funds; or 2. The entire amount of excess funds. Bellarmine must return this amount even if it did not keep this amount of your Title IV funds.

If Bellarmine is not required to return all of the excess funds, you must return the remaining amount. Any loan funds that you must return, you (or your parent for a PLUS Loan) repay in accordance with the terms of the promissory note. That is you make scheduled payments to the holder of the loan over a period of time. Any amount of unearned grant funds that you must return is called an overpayment. The amount of a grant overpayment that you must repay is half of the grant funds you received or were scheduled to receive. Bellarmine will return the unearned grant funds for you, which may cause you to owe a balance.

The requirements for Title IV program funds when you withdraw are separate from any refund policy that Bellarmine has. Therefore, you may still owe funds to Bellarmine to cover unpaid institutional charges. Bellarmine may also charge you for any Title IV program funds that Bellarmine was required to return. If you don't already know what Bellarmine's refund policy is, see the previous section or, you can ask

for a copy in the Office of the Registrar. Bellarmine can also provide you with the requirements and procedures for officially withdrawing from school.

If you have questions about your Title IV program funds, you can call the Federal Student Aid Information Center at 1.800.4.FED.AID. TTY users may call 1.800.730.8913. Information is also available on "Student Aid on the Web" at www.studentaid.ed.gov. The Office of Financial Aid and the Bursar at Bellarmine are also available to assist you.


Military Service and Serious Illness or Injury

Students enrolled in courses at the time they are called for active military service will have their tuition and fees reversed ONCE THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS are provided to the Bursar. Any financial aid will be adjusted according to the Title IV and Institutional Refund policies. Enrolled students who become incapacitated by serious illness or injury

may be entitled to a tuition adjustment ONCE THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS are provided to the Bursar. A letter from the student's doctor describing the illness or injury, along with any supporting documents, such as proof of a hospital stay, is required. Any financial aid will be adjusted according to the Title IV and Institutional Refund policies. All fees are non-refundable.

VETERANS BENEFITS

Students who have received Veterans benefits while attending Bellarmine during the current semester, will automatically be certified upon registration for the next semester. Returning students, not currently enrolled, as well as new students, should contact the Office of the Registrar 502.272.8133 for more information.
