Advanced Placement Policy: Bellarmine University offers academic credit, placement, or both to students who earn scores of 4 or 5 (a few departments accept scores of 3) on the Advanced Placement tests sponsored by The College Board. This table is a complete listing of how credits will transfer. Credit will not be awarded for both AP and IB exams or ACES (formerly Access) credit in the same subject. If you subsequently take a course at Bellarmine for which you received AP credit placement, you will not be awarded credit for that subsequent course; it would be considered a repeat. This information was last updated in November 2008.
