Priority Admission/Bellarmino Scholars Deadline

- Early notification of admission and merit award.
- Consideration for full-tuition award with study abroad stipend.
- Must receive completed admission application by December 1.
- Must complete Bellarmine Scholars essay.

See Essay section of this application. Most Bellarmine Scholar candidates have an ACT of 29 or higher and a GPA of 3.4 or higher. Other factors such as strength of curriculum, honors and awards are also considered.

FEBRUARY 1


Regular Decision


