

Of the 900 graduates in the SU15, FA15, and SP16 semesters, 367 responded to the survey sent via email, a response rate of 40.7%. With assistance from campus partners, we increased our knowledge rate of those who initially responded they were will seeking employment or education and those who did not respond at all. Our overall knowledge rate is 54.4% (490/900). The figures throughout this report exclude from the population those who (a) responded that they were not seeking employment or education (n=2).

In sum, 85.3% of all graduates for which we have information are employed, 10.6% are enrolled in a program of continuing education, 2.2% are seeking employment, 0.4% are planning to continue education but not yet enrolled, 0.4% are participating in the U.S. military, and 1% are participating in a volunteer or service program (e.g., Peace Corps).
