ANNOUNCEMENT OF STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2013 CCSA STUDY ABROAD

CCSA and Bellarmine University would like to announce a call for scholarship applications in support of summer or winter programs overseas language study. Scholarships will be awarded on a competitive basis to students accepted in CCSA programs.

Scholarships begin at \$500 and will be awarded in Spring in support of study programs that begin on or before December 31 of the calendar year.

Who is eligible?

Applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- A. Status as full-time Bellarmine student in good standing and a 3.0 overall GPA.
- B. An essay between 3 5 pages, typed and doubled spaced on the following topic: "What visions and values do you believe should guide a leader (in Business, Government/Law, Science, or Media/Communications) in today's global society?"
- C. Acceptance into an established CCSA program of overseas study. (Students applying to such programs who have not yet been informed of their acceptance are eligible to apply. Bellarmine reserves the right to award scholarships contingent upon future acceptance.
- D. Within thirty days after his/her return to the United States, a scholarship winner must submit to the Director of International Programs a typewritten journal or report of activities (1500 word minimum). A summary of the study abroad experience must also be prepared for an evening presentation during the Fall (5 10 minutes: power point good quality slides, video, pictures, etc.)
- E. A scholarship winner must also agree to be available during the college's fall study abroad fair and other study abroad informational events.
- F. Upon return to the U.S., a scholarship winner must be paired with an incoming Bellarmine exchange student as a peer mentor for a minimum of one semester. This will include, but not be limited to, picking the incoming student up from the airport, assisting with dormitory check in, and general adjustment to the Bellarmine campus. (Orientation of the city, social invitations, etc.)

Awards are made in the form of a CCSA program cost reduction. Application form is below, Please submit to the International Programs Office (Miles Hall 149) by February 1.
