

Course Description  
**French Conversation**  
**(3 cr. hrs.)**

This course will develop the student's ability to communicate in French on a variety of topics at the intermediate to advanced level. Class time will be devoted to the discussion of print/audio/video material studied outside of class. An emphasis will be placed on idiomatic expressions, correct pronunciation, and vocabulary pertaining to current events in France and the Francophone world. Field trips and extensive, themed walking tours will be an integral part of the course that allow the exploration of the city's many cafes, picturesque parks, and other famous public spaces. In addition to speaking with classmates and the instructor, students will prepare for and complete activities in which they converse with Parisian shopkeepers and other natives in a controlled way. Site visits subject to change based on the availability of guest speakers residing in Paris.

## Program Overview

Study for one month in one of the world's most exciting cities! Paris is a city rich in contrasts where the very old and the very modern coexist in harmony. Within days you'll be able to navigate throughout its safe and sophisticated public transportation system and become one of its residents, rather than a tourist. Courses are designed to take full advantage of the city's abundant cultural resources. Outside of classes, you have ample opportunity to explore Paris at your own pace and discover for yourself some of its treasures. A day-long trip to Reims is planned to visits its iconic cathedral and enjoy the Champagne region. Three-day weekends give you a chance to travel throughout France and Europe if you wish. No knowledge of French is necessary to participate in this program.

## Accommodations & Meals

- \* Participants reside at the FIAP Jean Monnet, a large, modern residence in the 14th district.
- \* It is equipped with a restaurant and a cafeteria.
- \* KIIS students occupy rooms designed to accommodate four people
- \* Each room has a private full bathroom and WiFi access.
- \* Students eat breakfast in the restaurant and either lunch or dinner in the cafeteria at the FIAP.
