Bellarmine is pleased to announce a new study abroad award opportunity for Bellarmine students with financial need. Awards of \$500-\$1000 will be awarded every year to selected recipients and maybe used for the following:

- Travel expenses to/from the host country
- In country transportation
- Visa fees
- Daily expenses abroad

Applicants Must Meet ALL of the Following Criteria:

- Enrolled as a full or part time Bellarmine student in good standing
- Accepted in an established undergraduate/graduate Bellarmine approved program (for credit programs only: summer, semester or academic year)
- Established financial need (students should submit a personal statement explaining the student's current financial situation)

Applicants Must Agree to ALL of the Following:

Submit a complete application at least 8 weeks prior to the start of the program. Each application must include:

- A copy of the study abroad program application
- A one page student biography
- One faculty recommendation
- A one page report discussing your area of study/focus during your time abroad

Applicants Must Agree to ALL of the Following:

Within 30 days after his/her return to the United States, the award recipient must submit to the Director of International Programs the following three items:

- A typewritten concise report (a critical analysis, not a journal) of the international study experience (300-500 words)
- The Knightly Adventures Abroad Form (template provided) for the BU study abroad website. Include at least 2 pictures of the award recipient abroad (preferably one with the student wearing a BU t-shirt).
- A hand written thank you note for the donor

Please note: Pictures, reports and overview may be used for other P.R. purposes and incorporated into BU promotional events.
