

## Death and Dungeons in Past and Present England (IDC 301 or ENGL 200)

Explore the changing roles & meanings of death in England & western culture. Study the changes in death's meaning through careful study of historical texts; readings in thanatology; & various forms of the elegy. Students will consider how our denial of death & our faith in science has changed how we approach death & how we choose to live before it. Excursions include fossil digging on the Jurassic Coast, the Tower of London, Warwick Castle, Beachy Head in Sussex, and visiting the graves of the famous & infamous.
