

Assistant Certified Athletic Trainer

POSITION STATUS: Regular, 10 month, full-time position

Job Summary: Assist the Head Certified Athletic Trainer in providing services for all Bellarmine University student athletes.

Essential Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Cover intercollegiate practices and games for teams as assigned by the Head Certified Athletic Trainer. Provide appropriate first aid and emergency medical care and referral of athletes injured during such times. Maintain lines of communication of status of injured athletes with appropriate personnel.
- Under the guidance of the Team Physician, work with coaches and athletes in the prevention of athletic trauma or conditions that adversely affect the health or the performance of the athlete. Management (first aid, evaluation, treatment and rehabilitation) of athletic trauma or other medical problems that affect the intercollegiate athletes. Counseling of the athlete in various health-related areas such (1) nutrition, (2) relaxation and tension control, and (3) personal health habits. This is to be done using such physical modalities as heat, light, sound, colds, electricity, or mechanical devices related to rehabilitation and treatment.
- Assist in the daily supervision, maintenance and operation of the Athletic Training Room.
- Assist in administrating the documentation of all injuries that occur in connection with Bellarmine University athletics. Follow guidelines established by athlete's insurance for compliance when making referrals.
- Assist in the supervision and education of student athletic trainers.

Minimum Qualifications: Bachelor of Science or Arts degree required, as well as certification by both the National Trainers Association and the Kentucky Board of Medical Licensure.
