

**International Baccalaureate Policy:** Bellarmine University offers academic credit and some placement to students who earn scores of 5, 6, or 7 on the International Baccalaureate exams. Some exams are only accepted at the Higher Level. This table is a current listing of how credits will transfer. Credit and placement for exams not included on this list will be determined on an individual basis after review by the Registrar and appropriate department chair. Credit will not be awarded for both IB and AP exams or Access/ACES credit in the same subject. If you subsequently take a course at Bellarmine for which you received IB credit placement, you will not be awarded credit for that subsequent course; it would be considered a repeat. This information was last updated in July 2007.
