

### Creating and Accessing Your Account

1. Go to <https://central.nacelink.com/students?sitekey=bellarmino> and click on the "Register" button.
2. Enter all required account information and click on the "Submit Registration" button.
3. Click on the link provided in your confirmation email and then on the "Return to Login Page" button.
4. Enter your email address and password and click the "Login" button.
5. If prompted for additional information, choose your Degree Level and Major(s) and click the "Save" button.

- Home Page – Access the Student User Guide, FAQ's, announcements and links to employer research, career advice and news.
- Profile – Update your personal information, academic information and password.
- Documents – Upload and manage up to 20 resumes, cover letters, transcripts, writing samples and other files to apply for positions online.
- Jobs – Search for and apply to jobs and internships, flag your favorites and create search agents to find and automatically email you opportunities that match your criteria.
- Extended Job Search – Specify keywords and a targeted geographic area to locate opportunities.
- Applications – View all jobs for which you have applied through NACElink and view documents submitted to employers.
