Required undergraduate accounting courses (36 hours): Acct. 101, 102, 211, 212, 2XX, 313, 317, 318, 3XX, 414, 418, and 424. Required related courses: B.A. 103, 203, and 403; Econ. 111, 112, 410 or BA 346; Math. 125 or 117 and 205 or 314; Comm. 205; Psych. 102. Students are admitted to the Weekend MBA program (GMAT required) at the beginning of their fourth academic year. The MBA courses are taken on an every-other-weekend schedule. The first eighteen credits of the MBA program satisfy eighteen credits for the undergraduate accounting degree, B.A. 301, 305, 315, 346, ECON 405, and a free elective. The Weekend MBA program also includes an international experience/trip. A Bachelor of Arts in Accounting degree is conferred at the end of four years. An MBA degree is conferred at the end of four & one-half years.
