REQUIREMENTS FOR A POST-BACCALAUREATE ACCOUNTING CERTIFICATE – DESIGNED FOR STUDENTS WHO HAVE COMPLETED A BACHELOR’S DEGREE IN ANOTHER FIELD – QUALIFIES FOR THE CPA EXAM

PREVIOUS DEGREE IN BUSINESS: 27 Total Hours (24 Accounting Hours)

A bachelor’s degree, in a business field, from an accredited college or university and completion of the following courses: Acct. 211, 212, 2XX, 313, 317, 318, 414, 418, and BA 403. A minimum of twenty-four of the hours must be earned at Bellarmine University. Total college hours must equal 150, total business 39 hours, and total accounting 27 hours, to sit for the CPA examination in Kentucky. Note that an undergraduate business degree typically includes six credits of principles of accounting.

PREVIOUS DEGREE IN NON-BUSINESS FIELD: 39 Total Hours (30-33 Accounting Hours)

A bachelor’s degree, in any field, from an accredited college or university and completion of the following courses: Acct. 101, 102, 211, 212, 2XX, 313, 317, 318, 414, 418; BA 203, 403, and three hours of business or accounting elective. Previous accounting principles and business coursework may be substituted for Acct. 101, 102, BA 203, and the business elective. A minimum of twenty-four of the Accounting hours must be earned at Bellarmine University. Total college hours must equal 150, total business 39 hours, and total accounting 27 hours, to sit for the CPA examination in Kentucky.
