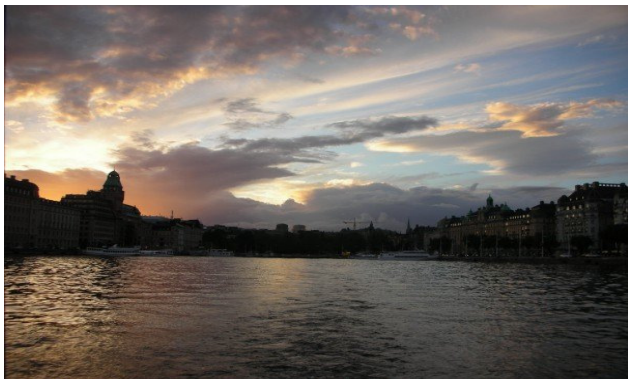




# ***Knightly Adventures Abroad***
