Definition of a Principal Investigator

A Principal Investigator has absolute responsibility for the overall conduct of a sponsored project, including all technical, programmatic, financial, compliance and administrative aspects. As well, the Principal Investigator is responsible for controlling the technical direction and academic quality of the project, and will ensure that a sponsored project is carried out in compliance with the terms, conditions, and policies of the Sponsor and the University. The Dean of the School will have a significant oversight responsibility, however that will not alleviate the PI's responsibility level.
