


<u>Notes</u>

1. The reporting period for the 12-month enrollment component is July 1 of the previous calendar year to June 30 of the next calendar year. For example, for 2015-2016 the headcount includes all students enrolled from July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016.

2. Per IPEDS, the following method is used to convert the credit hours reported to an indicator of full-time equivalent students:

Undergraduate credit hours are divided by 30, assuming a full-time student courseload of 15 credit hours per semester.

Graduate credit hours are divided by 24, assuming a full-time student courseload of 12 credit hours per semester.

Doctoral — professional practice (DPP) FTE student enrollment is permitted by IPEDS to be reported based on Bellarmine's definition of a full-time equivalent DPP student. This calculation also uses 24 as a divisor.
