



Appendix

Undergraduate Notes

- 1. All counts shown in the table above represent official census, unduplicated headcounts using the IPEDS standard.
- 2. Transfers and readmitted students are included in class counts on the basis of earned credit hours.
- 3. High School students who were enrolled in the ACES Program are not included in this report.
- 4. Fr: Freshmen students (including first-time students) are those with less than 30 cumulative earned hours.
- 5. So: Sophomore students are those with more than 30 cumulative earned hours but less than 60.
- 6. Jr: Junior students are those with more than 60 cumulative earned hours but less than 90.
- 7. Sr: Senior students are those with more than 90 cumulative earned hours.
- 8. Pb: Postbaccalaureate
- 9. Cert: Certificate
- 10. N.D.: Non-Degree
- 11. Undecided and non-degree students are counted in Bellarmine College (Arts & Sciences) unless they have an affiliation with a specific
