Appendix

Undergraduate Notes

1. All counts shown in the table above represent official census, unduplicated headcounts using the IPEDS standard.
2. High School students who were enrolled in the ACES Program are not included in this report.
3. Non-degree students are counted in Bellarmine College (Arts & Sciences) unless they have an affiliation with a specific BU School (e.g., non-degree Lansing students are designated UNDL and counted toward the Lansing School numbers).
4. Before FA 11, secondary education was offered as a minor only. Counts for secondary education minors:

5. Medical Lab. Science Certificate (CMDL) is only offered to visiting students from IU Southeast.
6. The Computer Information Systems bachelor's program is no longer accepting new students.

8. The Design, Arts, and Technology bachelor's program can only be added as a second major.
9. The Sports Administration bachelor's program was added as a new program in the 2014-2015 academic year.
