Undergraduate Notes

- 1. All counts shown in the table above represent official census, unduplicated headcounts using the IPEDS standard.
- 2. High School students who were enrolled in the ACES Program are not included in this report.
- 3. Non-degree students are counted in Bellarmine College (Arts & Sciences) unless they have an affiliation with a specific BU School (e.g., nondegree Lansing students are designated UNDL and counted toward the Lansing School numbers).
- 4. The standalone Music Technology bachelor's program is now part of the Bachelor of Music program and is not accepting new students.
- 5. Medical Lab. Science Certificate (CMDL) is only offered to visiting students from IU Southeast.
- 6. The Computer Information Systems bachelor's program is no longer accepting new students.
- 7. The Applied Information Technology bachelor's program is no longer accepting new students.
- 8. The Design, Arts, and Technology bachelor's program can only be added as a second major.
- 9. The Sports Administration bachelor's program was added as a new program in the 2014-2015 academic year.
- 10. The Radiation and Pre-Radiation Therapy bachelor's programs were absorbed from St. Catherine's in the 2016-2017 academic year.

Graduate Notes

- 1. MST (Taxation) was added as a new program in the 2012-2013 academic year.
- 2. Prior to SP 14, MLIT (Literacy) was coded as MRDG (Reading and Writing).
- 3. MSA (Analytics) was added as a new program in the 2014-2015 academic year.
- 4. The Leadership in Higher Education PhD program was added as a new program in the 2014-2015 academic year.
- 5. The Education Specialist (EdS) degree program was formerly called the Principalship program.
- 6. The Outreach Program for Educators (OPED) was formerly called Thornton Teachers Academy.
