- 5. The Medical Laboratory Science Certificate is only offered to visiting students from IU Southeast.
- 6. The Design, Arts, and Technology bachelor's program can only be added as a second major.
- 7. The Radiation and Pre-Radiation Therapy bachelor's programs were absorbed from St. Catherine's in the 2016-2017 academic year.
- 8. The Sports Administration bachelor's program was added as a new program in the 2014-2015 academic year.

Graduate Notes

- 1. The Education Specialist (Ed.S.) degree program was formerly called the Principalship program.
- 2. The Outreach Program for Educators (OPED) was formerly called Thornton Teachers Academy.
- 3. The College of Health Professions was called the Lansing School of Nursing and Health Sciences until June 2017.
- 4. The MHS programs in Medical Laboratory Science and Respiratory Therapy were added in the 2016-2017 academic year.
- 5. The Athletic Training (MSAT) program was added in the 2016-2017 academic year.
- 6. The Analytics (MSA) program was added in the 2014-2015 academic year.
- 7. The Education and Social Change (Ph.D.) program was split from the Ed.D. program in the 2016-2017 academic year.
