## **Undergraduate Notes**

- 1. All counts shown in the tables above represent official census, unduplicated headcounts using the IPEDS standard.
- 2. High School students who were enrolled in the ACES Program are not included in this report.
- 3. Non-degree students are counted in Bellarmine College (Arts & Sciences) unless they have an affiliation with a specific BU School or College.
- 4. The standalone Music Technology bachelor's program is now part of the Bachelor of Music program and is not accepting new students.
- 5. The Medical Laboratory Science Certificate is only offered to visiting students from IU Southeast.
- 6. The Design, Arts, and Technology bachelor's program can only be added as a second major.
- 7. The Radiation and Pre-Radiation Therapy bachelor's programs were absorbed from St. Catherine's in the 2016-2017 academic year.

## **Graduate Notes**

- 1. The Education Specialist (Ed.S.) degree program was formerly called the Principalship program.
- 2. The Outreach Program for Educators (OPED) was formerly called Thornton Teachers Academy.
- 3. The College of Health Professions was called the Lansing School of Nursing and Health Sciences until June 2017.
- 4. The MHS programs in Medical Laboratory Science and Respiratory Therapy were added in the 2016-2017 academic year.
- 5. The M.S. in Athletic Training was added in the 2017-2018 academic year.
