ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

Bellarmino finished in the Top 2 of the ASUN Academic Standings in each of its two seasons in the conference for percentage of student-athletes with a 3.0 or better for the year. BU was the 2020-21 ASUN Academic Champion. In spring 2022, our student-athletes achieved a 3.38 overall GPA, with 53 earning a 4.0, and every team attained an average GPA above 3.0.

Academic Progress Rate (APR): APR reflects a scholarship student-athlete being in good academic standing and maintaining appropriate progress toward a degree. Bellarmine's APR was 994 out of 1,000. The national average across all teams was 984. Bellarmine had 15 teams post scores of 1,000 for 2020-21.

Honors Program Student-Athletes: Nearly 12% of our student-athletes, representing 22 teams, are part of the Honors Program. Seventeen first-year student-athletes are in the Honors Program.
