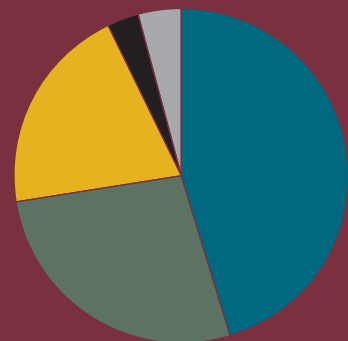

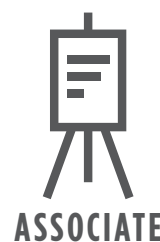

BELLARMINE INTERNSHIPS

At Bellarmine, we guarantee every student the opportunity to have an internship, develop a career plan and build a professional network.

TYPICAL INTERNSHIP CRITERIA:

- 90 or more hours (needed for 3 academic credit hours)
- 10 or more hours per week
- 8 or more weeks duration
- Compensation determined by experience/major (General: \$10-\$12; Specialized: \$15-\$25)

For further information concerning the legal requirements and definitions of internships, we recommend you review the National Association of Colleges and Employers Position Statement at www.bellarmine.edu/studentaffairs/careercenter/guarantee. Students complete internships throughout the fall, spring, and summer terms. Advance recruitment is recommended of 3 - 10 months, depending on the field of study.
