

Impact Grant Overview

The Impact Grant program is an effort to be a collaborative partner in the local, regional, and global community. Grants are awarded for community engagement projects that enrich learning and scholarship, prepare globally fluent and engaged citizens, and address critical social issues.

AMOUNT

Grants are awarded in the amount of \$50-\$500.

PROCESS

1. Discuss the project or initiative with your intended community partner to seek feedback and approval.
2. Complete the [Impact Grant Application](#) and submit to etodd@bellarmine.edu. *Student applicants must have a faculty or staff sponsor to be eligible for the Impact Grant. The Center for Community Engagement staff can serve in this role and provide resources and support if needed.*
3. Committee will review the proposed project/initiative and provide project feedback.
4. If the committee approves the project/initiative, applicants will complete an [Acceptance Agreement](#) and commit to the guidelines of the grant program. *Approved applications may match the requested amount of funding or may be approved for a lower amount no less than \$50.*
5. Applicant will implement the project/initiative.
6. Applicant will provide documentation of all funds spent on a [Budget Tracking Sheet](#) and complete an [Impact Grant Evaluation](#).
