This program is found in compliance with the EPSB program requirements.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL GRADES P-5 (Master's (119); Master's Option 6 (183))

This program is found in compliance with the EPSB program requirements.

*MIDDLES GRADES 5-9: ENGLISH, MATH, SCIENCE, SOCIAL STUDIES (Baccalaureate (2254, 2158, 2350, 2446))

These programs are found in compliance with the EPSB program requirements.

* These programs requires two subject areas for certification. Bellarmine University requires one of these two areas to be Learning and Behavior Disorders.

*MIDDLES GRADES 5-9: ENGLISH, MATH, SCIENCE, SOCIAL STUDIES (Master's (2256, 2160, 2352, 2448); Master's Option 6 (2257, 2161, 2353, 2449))

* This program includes an option for single content area certification.

ART GRADES P-12 (Baccalaureate (2))

The program was closed upon request of the EPP on September 12, 2017. Candidates have until June 30, 2021, to complete the program and receive a recommendation for certification from Bellarmine University.

INTEGRATED MUSIC GRADES P-12 (Baccalaureate (29))

This program is found in compliance with the EPSB program requirements.

LEARNING AND BEHAVIOR DISORDERS GRADES P-12 (Baccalaureate (33))

This program is found in compliance with the EPSB program requirements.

*This program requires dual certification with either P-5 or 5-9.

LEARNING AND BEHAVIOR DISORDERS GRADES P-12 (Master's (124); Master's Option 6 (184))

These programs are found in compliance with the EPSB program requirements.

*These programs require dual certification with either Elementary, Middle School or Secondary Education.

ADVANCED/ADDITIONAL CERTIFICATION PROGRAMS:

LITERACY SPECIALIST ENDORSEMENT GRADES P-12 (Certification only (1909), Master's for Rank II (1426), Master's for Rank I (1910), Rank I non-degree (5386))

These programs are found in compliance with the EPSB program requirements.

ENDORSEMENT FOR TEACHER LEADER GRADES P-12 (1247)

This program is found in compliance with the EPSB program requirements.

LEARNING AND BEHAVIOR DISORDERS GRADES P-12 (certification option in MA (2640) and Rank I (92) programs)

These programs were closed by request of the institution on September 12, 2017. Candidates have until June 2022 to complete the program and apply for certification/rank change.

TEACHER LEADER (Master's for Rank II (1246))

This program is found in compliance with the EPSB program requirements.

PLANNED PROGRAM FOR RANK I (Master's (1902) and 6th year non-degree (1901))

These programs are found in compliance with the EPSB program requirements.

SCHOOL PRINCIPAL GRADES P-12 (Specialist Level I (1905), Option 6 Specialist Level I (1908))

The information demonstrating compliance with 16 KAR 3:090 has been submitted for review; however, the review and approval process has not yet been completed.

SCHOOL PRINCIPAL GRADES P-12 (Certification only Level II (2684), Option 6 Certification only Level II (3083))

The information demonstrating compliance with 16 KAR 3:090 have been submitted for review; however, the review and approval process has not yet been completed.

SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT (Doctorate (3557))

The previous regulation governing this certificate program was repealed. The new regulation (16 KAR 3:090) went into effect July 2019. The program must be submitted for review by December 1, 2020.
