ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

Bellarmine finished in the Top 3 of the ASUN Academic Standings in each of its last three years in the conference for percentage of student-athletes with a 3.0 or better for the year. **BU was the 2020-21 ASUN Academic Champion**. In fall 2023, our student-athletes achieved a 3.32 overall GPA, with 66 earning a 4.0, and every NCAA sponsored team attained an average GPA above 3.0.

Academic Progress Rate (APR): APR reflects a scholarship student-athlete being in good academic standing and maintaining appropriate progress toward a degree. Bellarmine's APR was 986 out of 1,000. Bellarmine had 9 teams post scores of 1,000 for 2022-23.

Honors Program Student-Athletes: Over 8% of our student-athletes, representing 18 teams, are part of the Honors Program. Sixteen first-year student-athletes are in the Honors Program.
