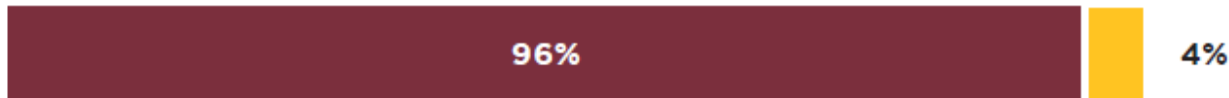

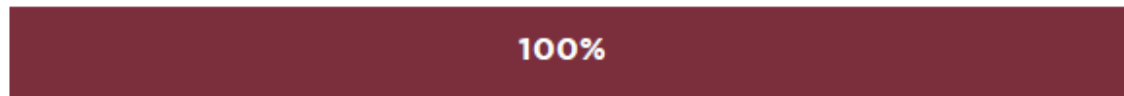

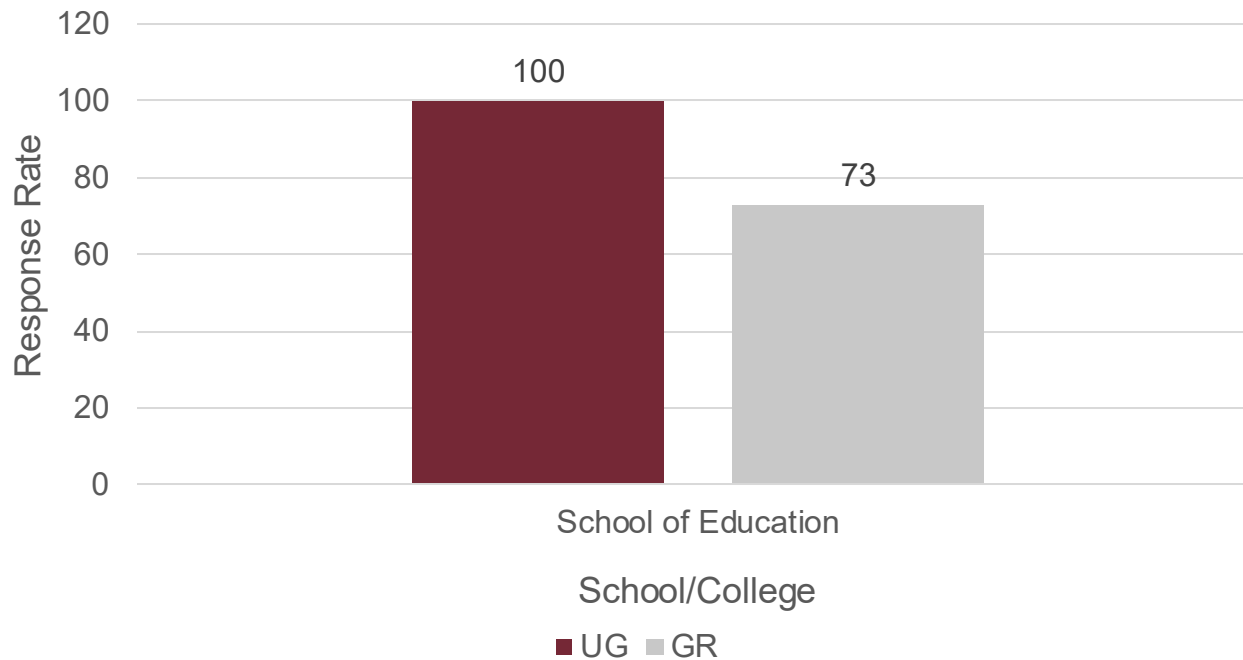

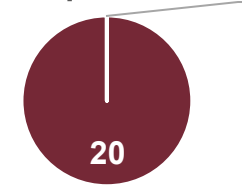


# Overall Knowledge Rate: 79%

UG (20) and GR (71) by Response Rate

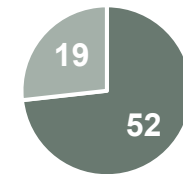

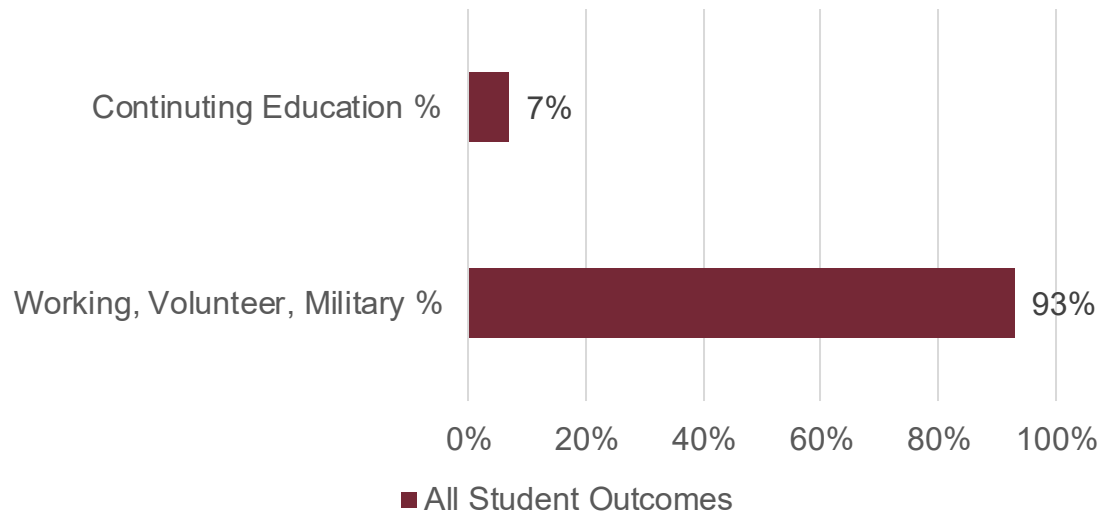

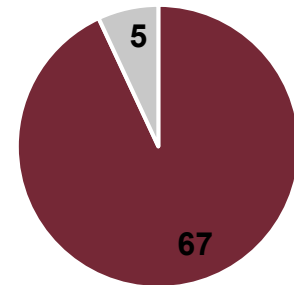

## ALL Student Outcomes (100% Success)



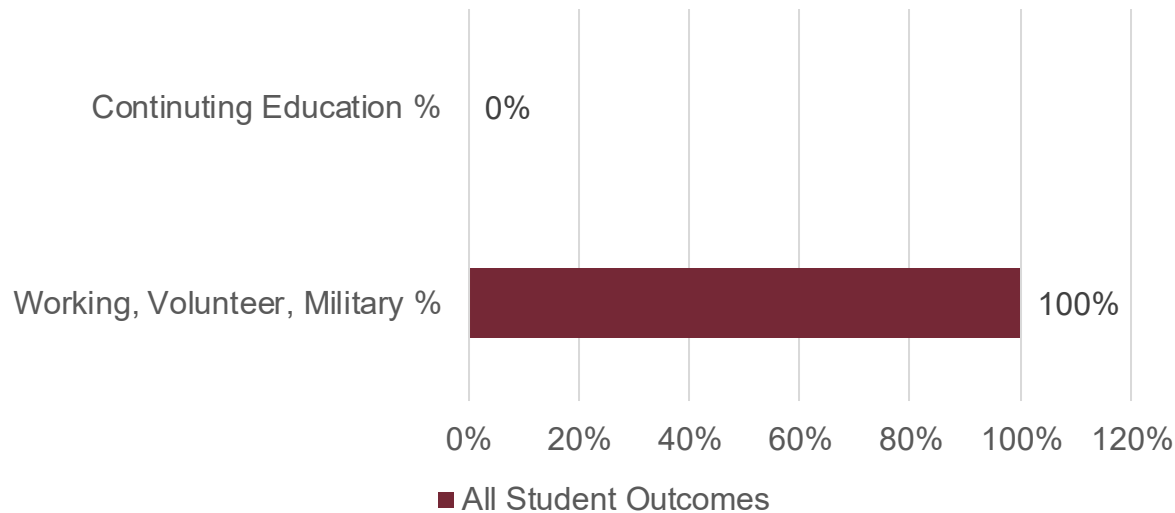

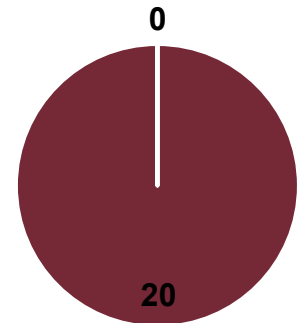

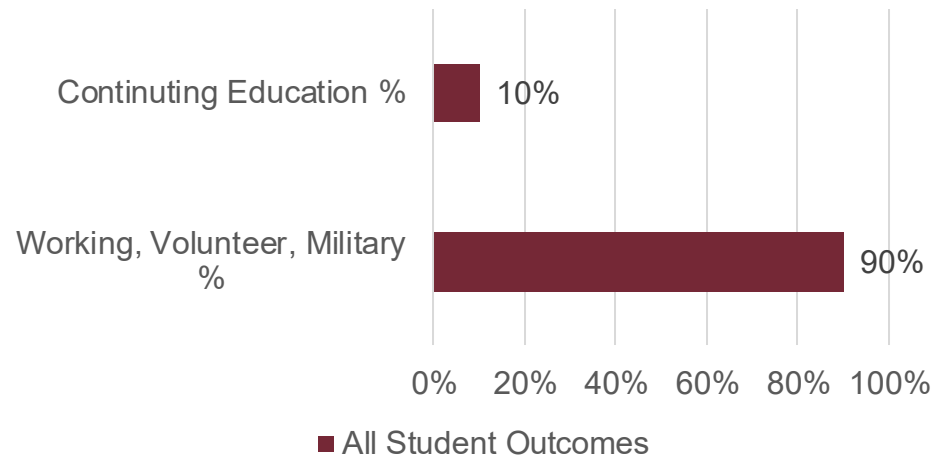
