5th Annual Undergraduate Ethics Essay Competition

Award: Two prizes will be awarded in the amount of \$250.00 each.

Contest Deadline: Thursday, February 14, 2019 at 11:59 p.m. EST

Goal of the Competition:

This annual competition is designed to help raise awareness of today's urgent ethical issues confronting our society and to inspire students to reflect upon the various dimensions of the issue. This year we are holding an open call for proposals and encourage students to submit papers they have written on ethical issues.

Award:

The authors of the winning essays will each receive a **cash award of \$250.00**. In addition, the authors will publicly present his/her/their papers on **Tuesday, March 19 at 11 a.m.** during Ethics Madness Month. The authors will read their papers at the reception, to be followed by a discussion among guests and Bellarmine faculty and staff.

Eligibility:

Registered full- or part-time undergraduate students at Bellarmine University during the spring 2019 semester.

Essay:

THIS IS AN OPEN CALL FOR PAPERS. ANY PAPER DEALING WITH AN ETHICAL TOPIC IS ELIGIBLE FOR THIS COMPETITION. Please submit papers that are no more than 7 pages in length.

Review Criteria:

- Clear articulation and expression of ideas.
- Carefully proofread essay.
- Good grammar, punctuation and paper mechanics.
- Well thought-out and focused essay.
- Creative, thoughtful, reflective and imaginative.

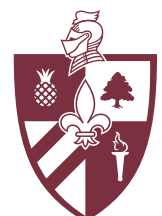
Submission Requirements:

- Your paper must be your own work and only one paper per student is allowed. Please do not submit papers longer than 7 pages.
- All papers must have a title.
- Please format your paper according to these requirements: 12-point Times New Roman font, double-spaced with 1" margins and numbered pages.
- Submissions will be judged anonymously so your paper must be prepared for blind review. Omit all identifying references like your name. Be sure to remove this as well in the 'properties' of the document.
- You must also include a separate cover page that includes your name, title of essay, word count, your major, graduation year, email address, student ID # and contact phone number.

Submission Guidelines for Students:

- Papers must be submitted electronically to kjohnson@bellarmine.edu.
- Papers must be saved as a Word or PDF document only.
- A separate cover page must also be saved as a Word or PDF document only.
- In the subject line of the email, please write "Prize in Ethics Submission 2019."
- All papers are due no later than 11:59 p.m. EST on Thursday, February 14, 2019.
- No paper or hardcopy submissions will be accepted.

The authors of the winning essays will be notified by 5:00 p.m. EST on Thursday, February 28, 2019.
