- 4. The Design, Arts, and Technology bachelor's program can only be added as a second major.
- 5. The Radiation and Pre-Radiation Therapy bachelor's programs were absorbed from St. Catherine's in the 2016-2017 academic year.
- 6. The Health Services and Senior Living Leadership major and the Health Services Executive Leadership major were introduced in the 2018-2019 academic year.

Graduate Notes

- 1. The Education Specialist (Ed.S.) degree program was formerly called the Principalship program.
- 2. The Outreach Program for Educators (OPED) was formerly called Thornton Teachers Academy.
- 3. The College of Health Professions was called the Lansing School of Nursing and Health Sciences until June 2017.
- 4. The MHS programs in Medical Laboratory Science and Respiratory Therapy were added in the 2016-2017 academic year.
- 5. The M.S. in Athletic Training was added in the 2016-2017 academic year.
- 4. The M.Ed. In Higher Education Leadership and Social Justice was added in the 2018-2019 academic year.
- 5. The Ph.D. in Health Professions Education was added in the 2018-2019 academic year.
