2. The Outreach Program for Educators (OPED) was formerly called Thornton Teachers Academy.
3. The College of Health Professions was called the Lansing School of Nursing and Health Sciences until June 2017.
4. The M.Ed. in Higher Education Leadership and Social Justice was added in the 2018-2019 academic year.
5. The Ph.D. in Health Professions Education was added in the 2018-2019 academic year.
6. The Master of Science in Analytics (MSA) degree program was put on hiatus in the 2017-2018 academic year.
