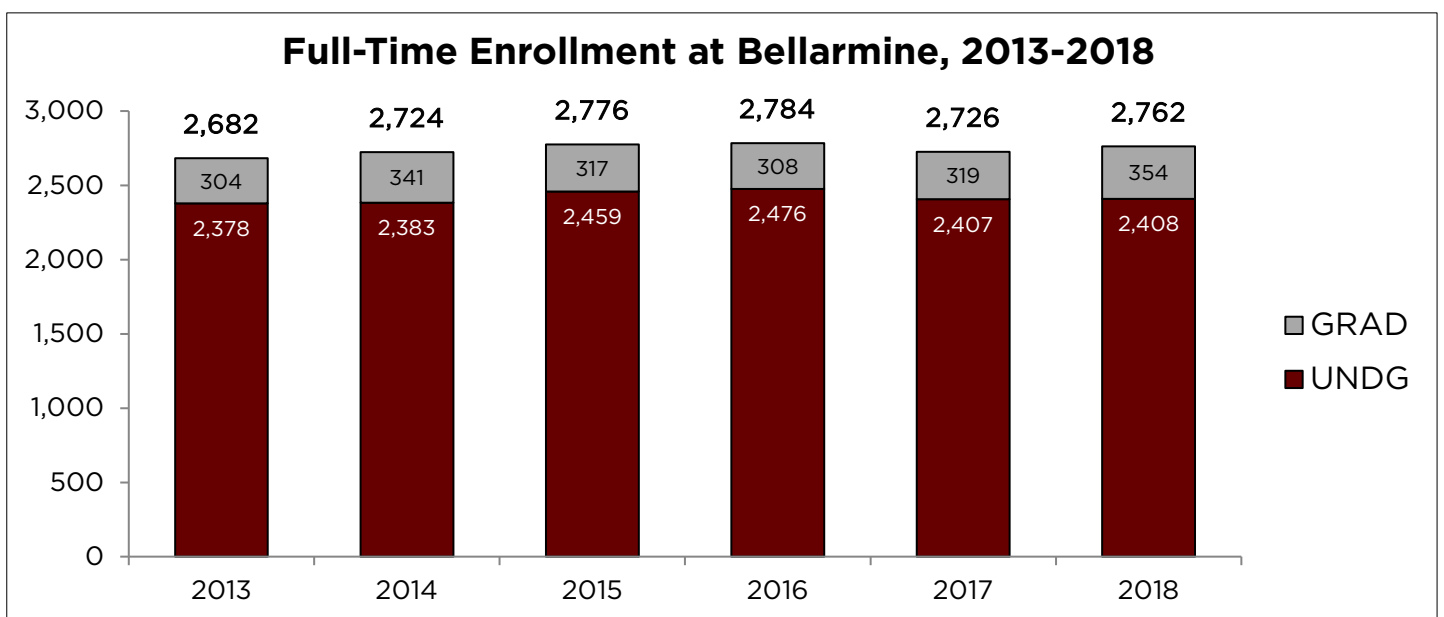

6. The Design, Arts, and Technology bachelor's program can only be added as a second major.
7. The Radiation and Pre-Radiation Therapy bachelor's programs were absorbed from St. Catherine's in the 2016-2017 academic year.

Graduate Notes

1. The Education Specialist (Ed.S.) degree program was formerly called the Principalship program.
2. The Outreach Program for Educators (OPED) was formerly called Thornton Teachers Academy.
3. The College of Health Professions was called the Lansing School of Nursing and Health Sciences until June 2017.
4. The MHS programs in Medical Laboratory Science and Respiratory Therapy were added in the 2016-2017 academic year.
5. The M.S. in Athletic Training was added in the 2016-2017 academic year.
