Certain federal regulations govern how international students may gain work experience in the United States. An international student on an F-1 visa may engage in temporary employment through authorized Curricular Practical Training (CPT) to gain working experience in their field of study. *[immigration regulation 8 CFR 214.2 (f)(10)]*

CPT must be an integral part of an established curriculum, and is defined to be alternative work/study, internship, cooperative education, or any other type of required internship or practicum that is offered by sponsoring employers through cooperative agreements with the school.
