Bellarmino Today: Bellarmine is ranked among the nation's best colleges by the Princeton Review and consistently ranks as one of the top universities in the South by US News & World Report. With a 12:1 student-to-faculty ratio, 60+ majors, an average class size of 20, and 70+ student organizations. This creates a perfect environment for Exchange students to engage both academically and socially.
