The American Nurses Association supports dedicated education units (DEUs) as a model to enhance student learning through peer teaching, improved clinical experiences, and collaboration between educators and clinical service providers. Norton Healthcare Center for Nursing Practice, a part of Norton Healthcare Institute for Education & Development, partnered with Bellarmine University's Lansing School of Nursing to create a DEU model that allows students in the Norton Healthcare Scholars Program to complete clinical rotations at multiple Norton Healthcare facilities.
