College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) Policy: Bellarmine University will accept CLEP exam credit based on the chart below. No more than 30 credits may be gained through outside testing avenues, including CLEP. To receive credit, official exam scores must be sent directly from The College Board to Bellarmine's Registrar's Office. CLEP exam scores are recorded on the Bellarmine transcript as earned credits and do not calculate into the Bellarmine GPA. CLEP scores do not count towards "residency" credits earned at Bellarmine. If a student subsequently take a course at Bellarmine for which CLEP credit has been granted, he/she will not be awarded credit for that subsequent course; it would be considered a repeat.
