

Bellarmino University FLATS Policy

Applicable for new exam results and students who started Spring 2021 or later

Foreign Language Achievement Testing Services (FLATS) Policy: Bellarmine offers language placement for passing (P) scores on the Brigham Young University FLATS exams. Students may earn academic credit for passing scores at the 102 and 201 levels of the exam. A maximum of 36 credit hours may be earned through external examinations. To receive credit, official exam scores must be sent directly from Brigham Young University to Bellarmine's Registrar's Office. FLATS exam credits are recorded on the Bellarmine transcript as earned credits and do not calculate into the Bellarmine GPA. Awarded exam credits do not count towards "institutional" credits earned at Bellarmine. If a student subsequently takes a course at Bellarmine for which FLATS credit has been granted, credit will not be awarded for that subsequent course; it would be considered a repeat.
