International Baccalaureate (IB) Policy: Bellarmine University offers academic credit and some placement to students who earn scores of 5, 6, or 7 on the International Baccalaureate exams. Some Bellarmine programs offer credit for scores of 4 on these exams, however some exams are only accepted at the Higher Level (HL), not the Standard Level (SL). A maximum of 36 credit hours may be earned through external examinations. This table is a current listing of how credits will transfer. Credit and placement exams not included on this list will be determined on an individual basis after review by the Registrar and appropriate department chair. IB exam scores are recorded on the Bellarmine transcript as earned credits and do not calculate into the Bellarmine GPA. IB scores do not count towards "institutional" credits earned at Bellarmine. If a student subsequently takes a course at Bellarmine for which CLEP credit has been granted, credit will not be awarded for that subsequent course; it would be considered a repeat.
