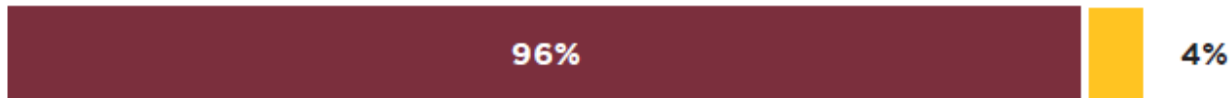

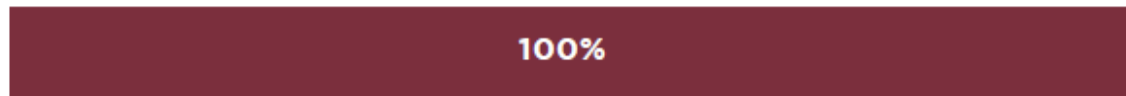

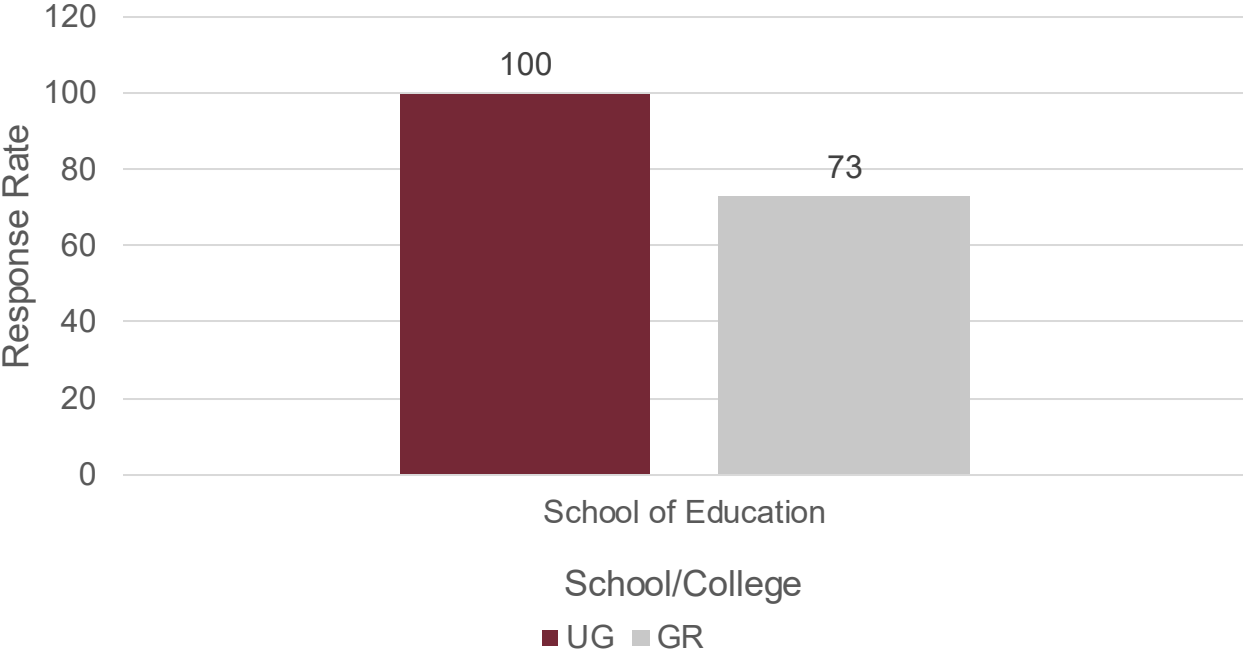

UG (20) and GR (71) by Response Rate

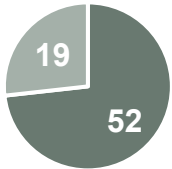

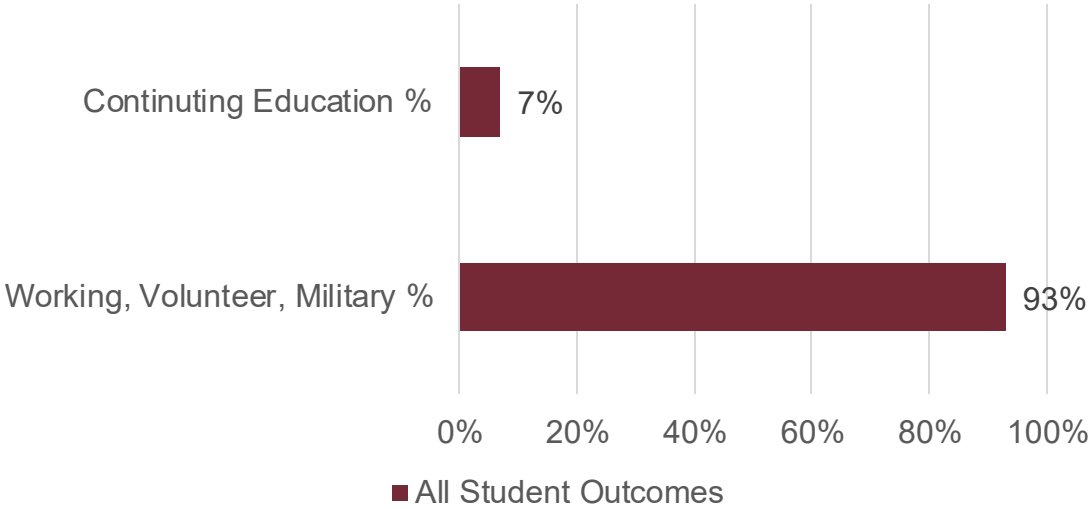

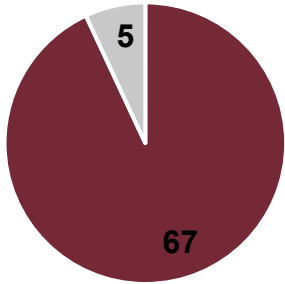

ALL Student Outcomes (100% Success)



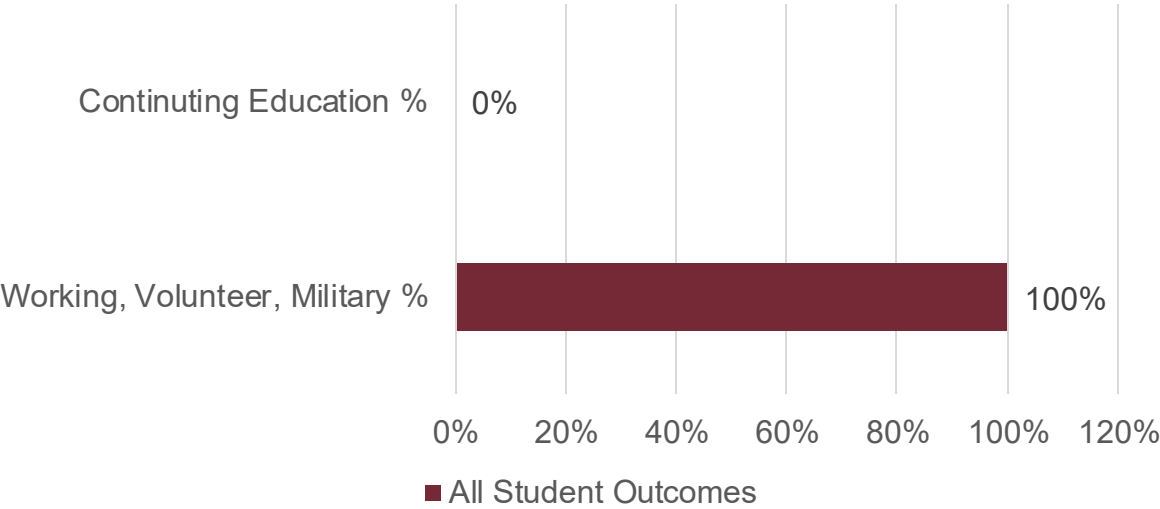

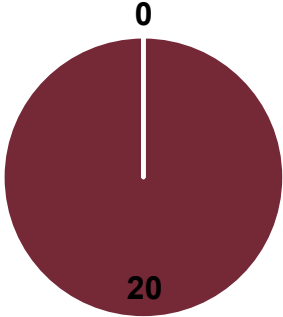

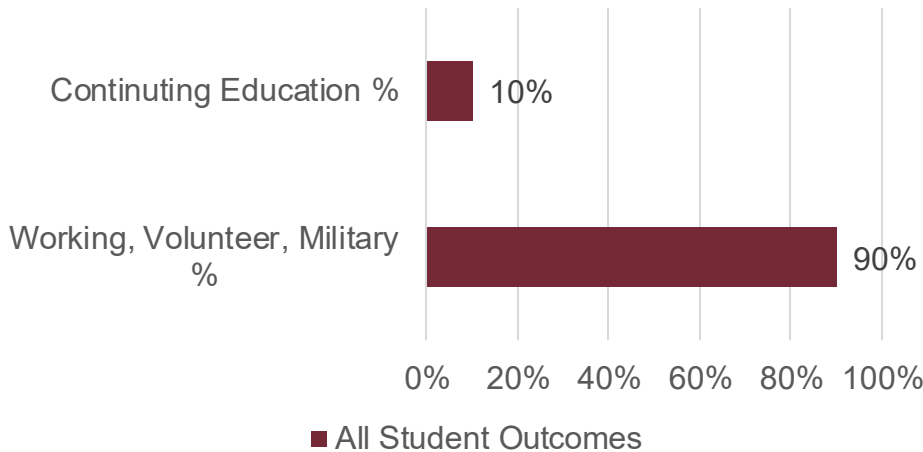

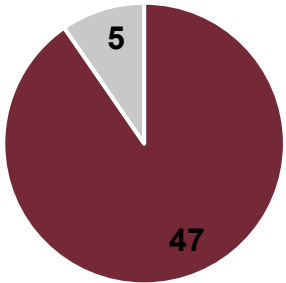
